AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. As used here Chattapaws means Chattapaws Agility, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assumes the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC, Chattapaws and Doug Yates Farms (including officers, directors, employees, members and agents of those entities), will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
6. This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. Exhibitor Handbooks are available free of charge by downloading from NADAC's website at www.nadac.com.

Trial guidelines

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded 1st thru 4th in all heights in all classes. Purple rosette qualifying ribbons will be awarded to qualifying runs. Rosette title ribbons will be available for dogs that finish a title at our trial. Chances is pass/fail and NO placement ribbons will be awarded.

Year End High in Trial awards:

All qualifying points earned at any and all Chattapaws Agility trials will go toward the year end awards. This will include all trials held by Chattapaws Agility that are in or out of the state.

Confirmation:

All Confirmation will be send via e-mail. **Please write your e-mail clearly, if I can't read it, you don't get a confirmation.** If you have not received a confirmation via e-mail it does not mean you are not in the trial.

If you did not receive an e-mail, please call trial secretary at (352) 789-1593 to confirm. Leave a message and I will call you back.

Measuring:

Only dogs jumping 16 inches or lower will be required to be measured. Anyone with permanent height card does not need to be measured. Skilled dogs do not need to be measured.

Move ups allowed for the weekend.

Check in and run order:

Check in time will be 5:00 pm on Friday, walk thru will start at 6:00pm and first dog on the line at 6:30 pm. On Saturday check in at 4:00pm and first dog on the line at 4:30 pm. First dog on the line at 5:00pm. Both days' classes will run Elite, Open, Novice, Big dogs to small. **This is subject to change.**

Class schedule:

Friday will run as follows: Friday: Regular, Jumpers, Chances, and Tunnelers. Saturday: Regular1 and Regular 2, Tunnelers, Chances, Weavers, Jumpers, Touch 'N Go.

The running order is subject to change. The judge will have the final decision in class order

Food:

There will be a concession stand at this trial. The Fast Food restaurants are just a few miles away if you prefer that.

Refunds:

There will be a \$25.00 charge for cancellation after the closing date. We have the right to refuse or refund entries at anytime. There will be no class credits for future trials. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Trial organizers will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the car and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee shall be asked to

Please Read.

We are here to have fun and want this trial to be a great experience for everyone. These trials are very laid back and take place in a relaxed atmosphere. No aggressive dogs or people are allowed.

If the exhibitors come out and help set jump heights then the trials run quite efficiently. If no one helps, then as main workers get tired, the trial will run late and slow. We appreciate your help and thank you in advance.

IMPORTANT.

Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels.

Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Motels:

Please make sure that you pick up after your dogs so that these motels/hotels will continue to accept dogs. Some restrictions may apply, Check with motels/hotels regarding rates and dog policy when making reservations. We do not guarantee that dogs are accepted. **Please make sure you tell the hotels that you are with the dog agility trial to get the discounts**
